GRUPO TELEVISA ISSUES STATEMENT CLARIFYING PROGRAM LICENSE AGREEMENT STATUS AS DESCRIBED IN VENEVISION PRESS RELEASE

New York and Mexico City, June 16, 2006—Grupo Televisa, S.A. ("Televisa"; NYSE:TV; BMV:TLEVISA CPO) today noted that in the press release issued by Venevision Investments LLC yesterday regarding Univision Communications there was a reference to a programming "contract which is in effect until 2017". In that regard, Televisa stated that, as to its separate programming license agreement with Univision, Televisa has previously given formal notice to Univision that, due to certain uncured and incurable breaches by Univision of that agreement, Televisa believes itself to have the right to terminate the agreement and is pursuing that position in its pending litigation with Univision.

Grupo Televisa, S.A., is the largest media company in the Spanish-speaking world and a major participant in the international entertainment business. It has interests in television production and broadcasting, production of pay television networks, international distribution of television programming, direct-to-home satellite services, publishing and publishing distribution, cable television, radio production and broadcasting, professional sports and live entertainment, feature film production and distribution, and the operation of a horizontal internet portal. Grupo Televisa also owns an unconsolidated equity stake in Univision, the leading Spanish-language media company in the United States, and in La Sexta, a free-to-air television venture in Spain.
